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Workshop Overview:

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

o Demonstrate the ability to use modern optical/video-assisted laryngoscopes for routine and rescue tracheal intubation.

o Compare and contrast different extra-glottic airway devices (EGADs).

o Demonstrate the ability to use EGADs for routine & rescue airway management. o Demonstrate the ability to use flexible optic bronchoscope (FOB) for intubation in the adult manikins: oral, nasal and via conduits.

o Demonstrate the ability to use FOB for intubation in the pediatric manikin: one, two and three-step techniques.

o Select the appropriate surgical airway procedure whenever indicated.

o Demonstrate the ability to apply techniques of minimally invasive surgical airway: crico-thyroidotomy (needle & surgical) on manikin.

o Demonstrate the ability to identify airway structures with the ultrasound on volunteers (role players).

o Demonstrate by the ultrasound, the hidden causes and fast reverse of hypoxia during airway management
